He also mentioned that healthcare sector contributes as one of the largest sector in terms of revenue generation and employment opportunities. Healthcare comprises hospitals, medical devices, clinical trials, outsourcing, telemedicine, medical tourism, health insurance and medical equipment. This session make student aware about current scenario of Pharma and Healthcare Industry.

Entrepreneurship Development in association with MCED, Pune.

On 24th August 2019 Lotus Business School in Association with MCED (Maharashtra Centre for Entrepreneurship Development) organized session on Entrepreneurship Development.
