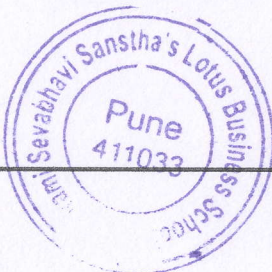

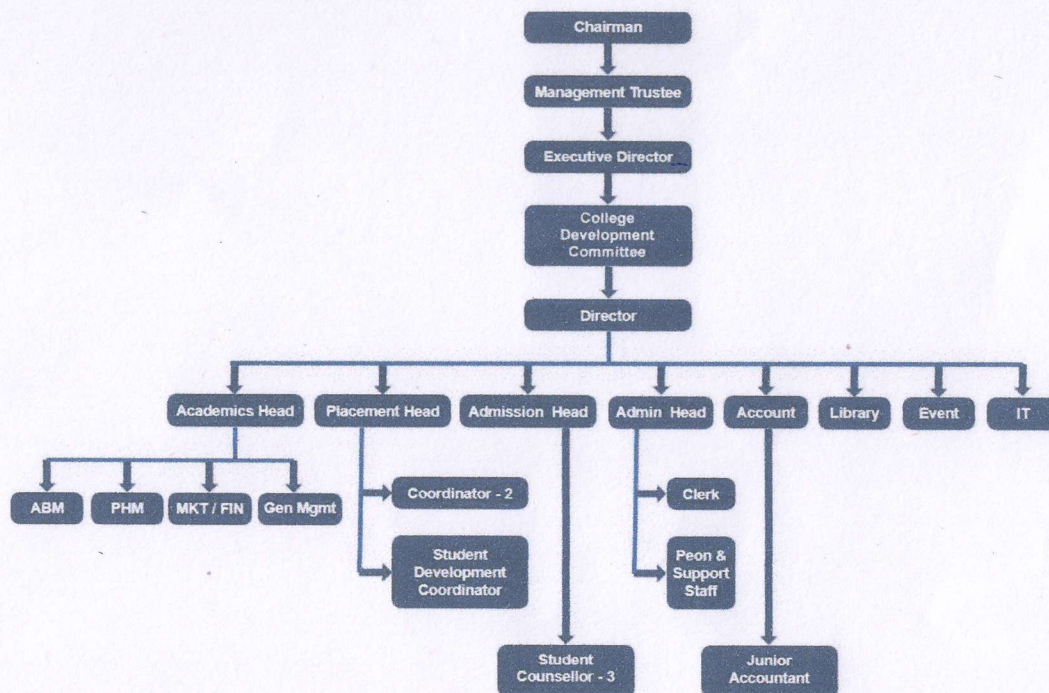

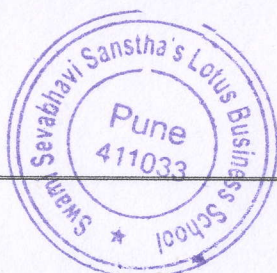
Organizational chart and processes

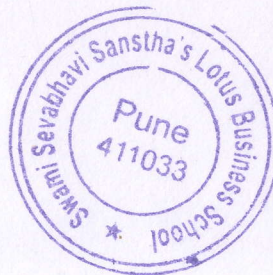
- i) The institute gives freedom to the students in conducting Extra & Co-Curricular activities to develop the skills & abilities.
