There is single, integrated and independent judiciary in India. The Supreme Court is the highest court of the land.

Indian Constitution contains 448 Articles in 25 parts and 12 Schedules and 105 amendments as of now.


Guest faculty Drishti Kaj, she conducted session on Constitution for students explaining them about fundamental rights on 26th Nov 2021, to mark the significance of the day.

She further added Right to Equality (Article 14-18), Right to Freedom (Article 19-22), Right against Exploitation (Article 23-24), Right to Freedom of Religion (Article 25-28), Cultural and Educational Rights (Article 29-30), right to Constitutional Remedies (Article 32).

Right and Articles were explained in detail to the students to know the importance of Fundamental rights which are enshrined in the constitution, it was for the development of personality of every individual and to maintain the human dignity. Fundamental rights protect the liberties of every individual. Article 32 is the armour and the heart and soul of the Indian constitution.

Corporate social responsibility is traditionally broken into four categories: environmental, philanthropic, ethical, and economic responsibility.



Implementation of Program:


